Current Challenge:

- 0 No clear service descriptions
- 0 No measurable outcomes
- 0 No ability to effectively set rates
- 0 No equitable path forward

AB 813 creates an innovative data-driven pilot project designed to improve the quality of services for people with developmental disabilities while more efficiently using state resources.

Currently, the lack of clear and consistent service definitions make it impossible to measure outcomes. The proposed pilot project included in AB 813 changes that.

AB 813 addresses the racial disparities, geographic inequities, service inconsistencies and funding deficiencies that historically challenged our developmental disability service system.

AB 813 Pilot Project

- Uses applied statistics and quality management tools to clearly define services and outcomes.
- Develops data to link quality outcomes with state resources
- Helps professionalize and strengthen the understaffed workforce.

The pilot project will create clear and consistent person-centered administrative service structures to address the diverse needs of people with developmental disabilities. It builds a path forward to measure outcomes and help deliver more equitable services with high quality outcomes.
